- · Monitor and maintain appropriate stock levels to avoid shortages and excess;
- · Ensure correct storage and labelling of parts and materials;
- · Issue parts to production and maintenance teams in a timely manner;
- Conduct periodic stock counts and reconciliations;
- · Liaise and build relationships with 3rd party suppliers ensuring high service standards are maintained;
- Schedule and coordinate routine maintenance, servicing, and repairs of the vehicle fleet;
